Nursing (Associate of Applied Science)

Prepares students for the NCLEX-RN. 90 credits. Prerequisites include anatomy & physiology and a competitive application. Clinical placements at regional hospitals.

Cybersecurity & Networking (AAS)

Covers network defense, ethical hacking, and cloud security. 92 credits. Aligns with CompTIA Security+ and Network+ certifications.

Welding Technology (Certificate)

Hands-on training in MIG, TIG, and stick welding. 45 credits. Prepares students for AWS certification and entry-level fabrication roles.

Business Administration (AST-Business)

Transfers to state universities' business schools. 90 credits. Covers accounting, economics, and management fundamentals.
